

Biologisk. KAKAO-FLIS

About Kakao-Flis®

1. Kakao-Flis® is a mulch, made of light, crisp shells of cocoa beans left over from chocolate production.
2. Lawnmower-friendly, robots included.
3. Keeps weeds down, nature's way, thus avoiding chemicals.
4. Deters Iberia-slugs and ants. They don't lay eggs in the cocoa shells.
5. Insulates against frost.
6. Wind resistant. The shells form a water-porous crust when wetted. 2-5 cms are enough.
7. Kakao-Flis® smells like chocolate after spreading.
8. Retains moisture. Well-suited for thirsty gardens!
9. Use it for mulching flower-beds, especially roses, perennials, fruit bushes and hedges. Also for outdoor pots.
10. Mulch with it all year round, unless there is snow.
11. If the crust gets washed away, lay another 1-2 cms on top.
12. Do not use the shells on paths or walking areas.
13. Not suitable for use in wet, humid greenhouses.
14. Does not contain resin, which can be harmful to certain plants, such as roses.
15. Despite smelling like chocolate, the shells are not suited for consumption by people or pets.
16. The shells can be spread on top of wood chips or bark chips to prevent slugs from laying eggs.
17. Please store the bags in a dry place, since they are not 100% waterproof.
18. Breaks down to humus by 1-2 cms a year, adding natural nutrition to the soil.
19. Good for acid-loving plants, e.g. rhododendrons.



DECLARATION:

Cocoabean shells. Organic mulching product approved by EU and Agriculture Ministry. Can be used for ecological gardening. C/N Ratio: 14-18.

WEIGHT %:

A natural and harmless mould can show up on the surface shortly after the shells are laid out. This disappears with a spray of water, if desired. The Big Bags and 50l bags are not 100% waterproof and it's recommended to store them in a dry place or cover them with a tarp. The shells are not suited for consumption by people or animals, such as dogs.
